Students build foundational skills through classical observational techniques, progressing from basic line work to full compositions. Drawing skills are transferable to painting, design, or digital art.

Ke'Shawn Hess is an emerging artist studying techniques in painting, sculpting, and drawing, influenced by local instructors Anita Tuccillo and Preston Jackson. He has shown in multiple galleries in the Peoria area. Hess has taught as a substitute teacher and coach at Peoria 150 schools for 5 years.
