# About the class:

Ken will teach some principles of watercolor in three evening sessions. The 1<sup>st</sup> evening, Ken will share a demo, insights on how to prepare the paper and how to sketch a drawing. In the following classes, Ken will lead the class in painting a landscape and a portrait. There will be some work expected outside of class. This class is for beginners but would benefit someone who is proficient also.

11" x 14" watercolor paper, brushes, paint, plastic white palates, drawing paper, metal rulers, hair dryers, masking tape, knife, paper towels, mounting board (homasote board with staples), water-soluble glue backed paper tape
